## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER DIRECTING RELEASE OF INFORMATION BY THE CHILD PROTECTION TEAM

THIS CAUSE, having come on before the Court on the Motion of the Health and Rehabilitative Services Attorney and Counsel for the Child Protection Team and the Court being otherwise fully advised of the premises, it is hereby,

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED IN ALL CASES BEFORE THE DIVISION OF ADMINISTRATIVE HEARINGS:

- 1. That the employees and consultants of the Child Protection Team shall appear at Properly Noticed Depositions after Proper Service of Subpoena on the Child Protection Team employee or consultant.
- 2. That the employees and consultants of the Child Protection Team shall appear at a properly noticed Administrative Hearing before the Division of Administrative Hearings after Proper Service of a Subpoena on the Child Protection Team employee or consultant.
- 3. That the employee or consultant of the Child Protection Team shall testify at deposition or hearing regarding all legally discoverable matters and shall release such information obtained during the course of their investigation of the allegations of abuse or neglect at the deposition or hearing in the matter before the Division of Administrative Hearings.
- 4. That upon receipt of a Valid, Properly Served Subpoena, the employee or consultant of the Child Protection Team shall provide the information and/or a copy of any video tape required.
- 5. All of the information and/or copy of the video tape released to the attorney of record shall be subject to the following conditions:
- a. The copy of the information and/or copy videotape shall be released to the requesting attorney and shall be maintained by said attorney as confidential, and shall be controlled by the attorney in a manner that will insure confidentiality.
- b. The cost for copying the information and/or videotape shall be paid by the requesting attorney.
- c. That any information and or videotape to be produced pursuant to this Order shall be viewed by the requesting attorney, and only those persons necessary to the pursuit of the case; and shall not be used for public display or other purposes not relevant to the judicial determination of the issues in the case.
  - 6. This Order is entered pursuant to Florida Statutes, Chapter 39 and 415.5055(3).
- 7. The parties' attorneys, and all proper persons viewing said information and/or videotape shall be controlled by this Order.
