PER CURIAM.

Calvin Douglas petitions for a writ of prohibition to bar his continued prosecution due to a purported speedy-trial violation. We decline to intervene. *See* Florida Rule of Criminal Procedure 3.210(b) (mandating competency proceedings when court has “reasonable ground” to believe defendant not competent to stand trial); *Maxwell v. State*, 974 So. 2d 505, 510 (Fla. 5th DCA 2008). Accordingly, the Petition for Writ of Prohibition is DENIED.
