FINAL ORDER AFFIRMING TRIAL COURT

The State of Florida appeals the trial court's Order denying the State's Motion to

Continue and granting the Defendant's Motion to Suppress, rendered January 26, 2007.

This Court has jurisdiction pursuant to Florida Rule of Appellate Procedure 9.030(c)(1).

On November 19, 2006, Jeffrey David Oren was arrested for driving under the influence. An officer with the Apopka Police Department prepared a charging affidavit, indicating that he had observed Mr. Oren's vehicle traveling at a high rate of speed, leaving the pavement three times and going into the grassy median, and crossing the center lane three times.
