- 1. Supervised visits shall be arranged and completed through the Children's Visitation Program. The supervised visitations will be scheduled by the Children's Visitation Program pursuant to the time frames, conditions, policies and procedures set forth by said program.
- 2. The Children's Visitation Program reserves the right to decline a referral. A Notice of Declination of Referral will be filed with the Court should this be the outcome.
- 3. The parties shall contact the Children's Visitation Program at (407) 742-2467 or by e-mail at oscvisitation@ocnjcc.org and complete the intake process and schedule orientation within ten (10) business days of the date of this Order. This process must be completed prior to scheduling supervised visits. The Children's Visitation Program is located at the Osceola County Courthouse, Family Court Services, Suite 3100, 2 Courthouse Square, Kissimmee, Florida 34741. Failure to contact the Children's Visitation Program within the 10 business days will result in the family being unable to use the Children's Visitation Program services.

4.	Visits will be for two hours on Saturday or Sunday (excluding Court holidays) and will be

	Supervised visits shall take place at the <u>Central Avenue Elementary School, 500 W. Columbia Street, Kissimmee, Florida 34741</u> during the hours set by the Children's Visitation Program.
5.	The Children's Visitation Program will conduct said visits until the expiration of the injunction or for a period of six months from the date of the first scheduled supervised visit

- 5. The Children's Visitation Program will conduct said visits until the expiration of the injunction or for a period of six months from the date of the first scheduled supervised visit (whichever comes first). At the conclusion of said time period, the Children's Visitation Program shall automatically terminate the visits unless extended by Order of the Court. Furthermore, the Children's Visitation Program services may be terminated by the program or Court at any time due to non-compliance of either party.
- 6. The cost of supervision will be:

Said payments shall be payable to the Clerk of the Court and paid at the Domestic Clerk's Office, located at the Osceola County Courthouse, 2nd Floor, 2 Courthouse Square, Kissimmee, Florida 34741, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. through 4:00 p.m. Visitation fees must be paid with a money order or cashier's check, NO PERSONAL CHECKS. Said payments should be made no later than the Friday before the scheduled supervised visitation.

- 7. The parties shall follow the rules, policies and directives of the staff of the Children's Visitation Program and law enforcement agency at the site. Failure to follow said rules, policies and directives will result in the family being removed from the Children's Visitation Program.
- 8. The parties shall notify the Children's Visitation Program at (407) 742-2467, at least two business days prior to the scheduled supervised visitation if they cannot keep a scheduled supervised visitation. Continuous and unexcused cancellations will be reported to the Court and will result in the family being removed from the Children's Visitation Program.
- 9. The Children's Visitation Program and law enforcement personnel at the site shall implement this Order by all lawful means in order to accomplish its purpose in providing safe and regular contact between the child(ren) and parents. Reports of the supervised visitation shall be submitted to the Court by the Children's Visitation Program.
- 10. The Court notes that there is an Osceola companion case #_____ and directs the Clerk of the court to file a copy of this order in said companion case number.
- 11. The parties are encouraged to establish their own visitation arrangements in a family court case. If the parties do establish their own visitation plan, they should enter into a written stipulation stating their plan and file it with the Office of the Clerk of the Court for Court review and possible approval. Otherwise, the supervised visits will continue for a period of six months from the date of the first scheduled supervised exchange.
- 12. Upon proper notice, this order may be reviewed, extended, modified or terminated upon a motion or written stipulation of the parties or at the Court's Initiative.
