- **16. Trial Briefs:** Not required, but if you choose to submit them, please provide hard copies to Judge Schreiber's Chambers (1710) at least **five (5) business days** prior to trial to allow adequate time for review.
- 17. Judicial Notice: Please follow the Evidence Code, Section 90.201-90.207, Florida Statutes
- 18. Witness Disclosure during Trial: The next day's witnesses shall be disclosed at the end of each trial day
- **19. Expert Opinions:** Are not admissible if not expressed in deposition or in an expert report *(unless no report was created and no deposition was taken)*
- 20. - 21. Jury Instructions and Verdict Forms File the originals with the Clerk and provide a copy in MS Word (in Times New Roman font 14 pt. double spaced) to the Judge either via USB flash delivered to the Court or via email to Wendy Blair, JA, at <a href="mailto:ctjawb1@ocnjcc.org">ctjawb1@ocnjcc.org</a>
  - They must be submitted/received no later than 3 business days **prior** to the first day of trial
  - Early substantive jury instructions, including the law, will be given **prior** to opening statements
  - Final jury instructions will be given before closing argument.
  - Jurors will be permitted to take notes and ask questions of witnesses (See F.S. 40.50 and Rule 1.452)
