- $\checkmark$  Foreclosure/Timeshare hearings are limited to five (5) per attorney per day.

If you have a motion that can be addressed on the pleadings, please provided a courtesy copy of the motion to chambers, and the court will rule on the motion, order the opposing side to respond, or direct the parties to set a hearing.\*\*\*

All short matter/ex parte hearings are held virtually. Evidentiary hearings are NOT to be set during short matter/ex parte. Parties must comply with the "Meet and Confer" Administrative Order 2021-03 before securing a hearing time.
