**AMENDED ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER DESIGNATING ACTING CHIEF JUDGE
FOR THE NINTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT**

Pursuant to the authority vested in me as Chief Judge of the Ninth Judicial Circuit of Florida, under Florida Rule of General Practice and Judicial Administration 2.215, I hereby designate **THE HONORABLE REGINALD K. WHITEHEAD** as Acting Chief Judge of the Ninth Judicial Circuit during any temporary absence of the Chief Judge of the Ninth Judicial Circuit when the Chief Judge cannot be reached.


THE HONORABLE REGINALD K. WHITEHEAD is also appointed as Acting Chief Judge of the Ninth Judicial Circuit in the event of the death or disability of the Chief Judge of the Ninth Judicial Circuit until a successor Chief Judge is elected to serve the unexpired term and is hereby vested with all and singular powers and prerogatives of the Chief Judge of the Ninth Judicial Circuit, including the power of substitution.

In the event that both the Chief Judge of the Ninth Judicial Circuit and the named Acting Chief Judge are unable to serve, the following order shall be followed to designate an Acting Chief Judge until either the Chief Judge of the Ninth Judicial Circuit or the named Acting Chief Judge can resume service:

1. The Administrative Judge for the Circuit and County Courts in Osceola County;
if unavailable then
2. The Administrative Judge for the Circuit Criminal Justice Division.

This Administrative Order is **effective July 1, 2021**, and shall continue until further order of this Court unless otherwise provided herein and superseding any provisions in prior Administrative Orders which may be inconsistent.
