ORDER VACATING ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2013-28

On March 21, 2024, the Supreme Court of Florida issued *In re Amends. to Fla. Rules of Gen. Prac. & Jud. Admin.*, 49 Fla. L. Weekly S70 (Fla. Mar. 21, 2024). The amendments to the Florida Rules of General Practice and Judicial Administration eliminates the necessity of Administrative Order 2013-28.


By the power vested in the chief judge under Article V, section 2(d) of the Florida Constitution, section 43.26, Florida Statutes, and Rule 2.215 of the Florida Rules of General Practice and Judicial Administration, unless otherwise provided herein, to continue until further order and superseding any provisions in prior Administrative Orders that may be inconsistent, it is

Administrative Order No. 2013-28, entered on November 21, 2013,
Administrative Order Governing Case Reporting Requirements for Real
Property Mortgage Foreclosure Cases;

having fulfilled the purpose for which it was issued and is no longer required is formally vacated effective **July 1, 2024**. Vacating an Administrative Order that vacates a prior Order does not revive the prior Order.
