
ORDER VACATING ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2018-24

The Ninth Judicial Circuit remains committed to the benefits provided to the criminal justice system, and the community, which are afforded by valuable alternatives to prosecution in appropriate cases. However, after consideration and discussion, the Court finds that Administrative Order No. 2018-24 is duplicative of existing programs of the State Attorney's Office and Problem Solving Court. Additionally, the Circuit does not have the resources available currently to adequately monitor the program.

By the power vested in the chief judge under Article V, section 2(d) of the Florida Constitution, section 43.26, Florida Statutes, and Rule 2.215 of the Florida Rules of General Practice and Judicial Administration, unless otherwise provided herein, to continue until further order and superseding any provisions in prior Administrative Orders that may be inconsistent, it is **ORDERED**:

1. Effective **immediately**, no new cases shall be assigned to the Pre-Trial Substance Abuse Education and Treatment Intervention Program for Felonies, (Program), established by Administrative Order No. 2018-24, Order Establishing a Felony Pre-trial Intervention Program.
2. The participants currently enrolled in the Program and in good standing shall be able to continue under the Program until the court finds each participant has either successfully or unsuccessfully completed the Program.
3. Upon the end of enrollment in the Program of the current participants in good standing, Administrative Order No. 2018-24, entered on September 24, 2018, Order Establishing a Felony Pre-trial Intervention Program, having fulfilled the purpose for which it was issued and no longer required becomes formally vacated. Vacating an Administrative Order that vacates a prior Order does not revive the prior Order.
