

DAILY SCHEDULE FOR MATTERS IN COURTROOM 6D AND BRC 3
EFFECTIVE APRIL 8, 2020

MONDAY THRU FRIDAY- The following matters are handled by the circuit criminal judges on a rotating basis:

8:30 a.m. In-custody misdemeanor pleas
In-custody felony pleas (only negotiated pleas will be accepted)

Both misdemeanor and felony pleas require a plea form.

9:30 a.m. Bond hearings for misdemeanors
Bond hearings for felonies
Bond hearings for FTA revocations

These bond hearings are limited to no more than 15 minutes per hearing.

11:00 a.m. This docket is reserved for hearings for the division whose judge is on duty, including out-of-custody pleas.

TUESDAY AND WEDNESDAY

1:30 p.m. On a rotating basis, the division judges will set non-essential or essential hearings for their divisions. These hearings will be only for cases that involve inmates or the necessity to use the BRC (ex. sentencings, out-of-custody pleas). Matters that do not require the presence of the defendant will be set in each judge's courtroom. (See procedures for those hearings.)

FRIDAY

1:30 p.m.- 5 p.m. **Circuit Criminal on rotating basis**

1:30 – 3:30 p.m. Bond and *Arthur* hearings over 15 minutes

3:30- 5 p.m. Any other essential matter from any division (ex. Habeas Corpus)
Non-essential felony matters with in-custody defendants (limited slots available)
