

Updating Your Address with the Court

Maintaining a current address with the Court is critical if you are to receive timely notices and orders from the Court. Failure to do so may cause you to miss court ordered deadlines and/or proceedings, and in some instances may result in issuance of a writ of bodily attachment.

Updating your address at the post office, on your driver's license, and/or with the Florida Department of Revenue will NOT update your address at the Court.

While each of those address updates are also important, to update your address with the Court you must come in person to the Clerk of the Domestic Court, or make your request in writing to the Clerk.
